Putting excessive pressure on children, pushing children against their will Giving only negative feedback Unequal treatment that could lead to resentment, jealousy or misinterpretation Spending a lot of time alone with children away from others Assisting with bathing or dressing tasks that children can do for themselves Smoking, drinking alcohol, misuse of illegal substances or the use of foul or offensive language Taking photographs without the appropriate consent Unofficial communication with a child through telephone or social media Allowing allegations or observations of bullying or abuse to go unchallenged, unrecorded or not
