Senior Open Competition

The competition is open to all amateur golfers aged 55 or over on the day of the competition, who are members of and hold a handicap from a CONGU affiliated Club.

Conditions of Entry:

The competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the R & A Golf Club St. Andrews and the local rules of Braehead Golf Club.

The competition will be 18 holes off stroke play, starting at 8.00am with the last players starting no later than 2.30pm.

Players will play off the yellow tees, (and back yellow tee at 16th)

The maximum course handicap will be 28.

The entry fee of £15 must be submitted with the entry, which can be booked through Braehead Golf Club website (Opens); BRS, Golf Now or other such booking sites.

Cancellations must be with the Club no later than 48 hours before the competition start date. After this time limit the entry fee is payable and may not be refunded.

The Senior Committee of Braehead Golf Club reserves the right to reject any entry and amend any conditions of entry, their decision will be final. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided over the last 9, 6 & 3 holes etc and thereafter as the competition committee may decide.

There will be three age categories with one scratch and three handicap prizes in each category. Magic two's will be rewarded.

No competitor may win more than one prize.

Full catering will be available throughout the day.
