MIXED OPEN GREENSOME COMPETITION

The competition is open to all amateur golfers aged 18 or above, who are members of and hold a handicap from a CONGU affiliated Club.

Conditions of Entry:

The competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the R&A Golf Club, St. Andrews and the local rules of Braehead Golf Club.

The competition will be played over 18 holes of Greensome stroke play, starting at 7.00 am, with the last players starting no later than 3.00 pm.

The maximum individual playing handicap is 28 for men & 36 for ladies. The combined team handicap allowance will be 0.6 of the lower individual handicap plus 0.4 of the higher individual handicap.

The team returning the lowest Nett score wins the trophy.

The trophy remains the property of Braehead Golf Club.

The appropriate entry fee must be submitted with the entry, which can be booked through Braehead Golf Club website (Opens), BRS, Golf Now or other such booking sites

Cancellations must be made with the Club no later than 48 hours before the competition start date. After this time limit, the entry fee is payable and will not be refunded.

The Committee of Braehead Golf Club reserves the right to reject any entry and amend any conditions of entry. Their decision will be final. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided over the last 9, 6, holes etc and thereafter as the competition committee may decide.

The prize fund will consist of 75% of the entry income, with a maximum of five handicap prizes and one scratch prize.

No competitor may win more than one prize.
