Gents Open Amateur Golf Competition

The competition is open to all amateur golfers aged 18 or above, who are members of a CONGU affiliated Club and hold a competition handicap of 11.8 or less.

Conditions of Entry:

The competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the R & A Golf Club St. Andrews and the local rules of Braehead Golf Club.

The competition will be played over 18 holes of stroke play, starting at 7:00 am, with the last players starting no later than 3.00 pm.

The competitor returning the lowest Scratch score wins the trophy.

The trophy remains the property of Braehead Golf Club. The trophy will remain at the club after the presentation.

The appropriate entry fee must be submitted with the entry, which can be booked through Braehead Golf Club website (Opens), BRS, Golf Now or other such booking sites.

Cancellations must be made with the Club no later than 48 hours before the competition start date. After this time limit, the entry fee is payable and will not be refunded.

The Committee of Braehead Golf Club reserves the right to reject any entry and amend any conditions of entry. Their decision will be final. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided over the last 9, 6, holes etc and thereafter as the competition committee may decide.

The prize fund will consist of 75% of the entry income, with a maximum eight prizes: four scratch, four handicap.

No competitor may win more than one prize.
